- 2. The Trustees have at the request of settlor agreed to act as Trustees of these presents upon the terms and provisions hereinafter contained.

Now This Indenture witnesseth as follows :-

or properties that may be acquired out of the same or otherwise may hereafter be subject to the trust (therein after referred to as "THE TRUST FUND") for the charitable objects and purposes and uses hereinafter expressed with the powers and on the terms and conditions herein contained of and concerning the same.

- 2. The name of the Trust shall be " SARADA SEVA TRUST "

 **CHARITABLE TRUST" and of the office of the trust shall be situated at No... Raigany which may be removed from time to time to such other place or places as the trustees may deem fit and proper at their discretion.
- 3. The objects of the Trust shall be :-
- i) to establish, Promote, Set-up, run, maintain, assist, finance support and/or aid to or help in the setting up and/or maintaining and/or running schools and other institutions orphanges, widow Homes, lunatic asylums, Poor houses or other establishments for relief and/or help to the poor, and/or infirm people and/or destitutes.
- ii) To give provide and/or render help and assistance in cash or kind to poor and/or destitute people, widow etc.
- iii) To give provide and/or render help and assistance to and/or implement any scheme for providing livelihood and upliftment of the poor.
- iv) To give, provide and/or render food, medicine and other help and/or assistance in any shape or form to the poor deserving and needy persons.
- v) To give, provide and/or render monetary and/or other help and assistance for the relief of persons and animals affected by natural and other calamities such as flood, fire, famine, cyclone, earth-quake, storm, accident, pestilence, drought, epidemic, unbearable cost of living and the like, to give denations, subscriptions or contributions to institutions, establishment, centres or persons doing relief work on such occasions.

- vi) To establish, maintain or grant aid for the establishment or maintenance of wells, tube-wells, tanks, water-reserviors and trees and constructions of an repairs to paths, roads, bridges etc. for the use of the Public.
- vii) To give, provide, distribute dhoties, blankets, rugs, woolen, clothings, quilts of cotton, woolen, silk, or their varieties of cloths or other articles of necessity and facilities for the poor.
- viii) To foster and encourage education and training in handicmafts, fine arts, among women folk in general and establish
 and found institutions imparting such education and to establish,
 maintain, support or help by monetary gifts or othersise,
 centres and institutions for women and children and to provide
 social welfare works for women and children.
- ix) To meet travelling, boarding and lodging expenses for students going abroad for higher commercial and technial education.
- xi) To open, found, establish, promote, set-up, run, maintain assist, finance, support and/or aid or help in the setting up and/or maintaining and/or running hospitals, charitable dispensaties, maternity homes, child welfare cultures, convalescent homes, Sanatoriums, hostels and other similar institutions or centres for rendering or providing medical relief and/or aid to the suffering humanities or for research centres and institutions for promitoons, promotions or research and education for medical science including surgery.

wii) To promote, assist and/or maintain in all activities by whoseever carried on or wherever carried on in India conformity with the objects of the Trust and as are conducive to the well being and general welfare of the nation or are condusive for advacement of any object or objects of general Public utility not involving/carrying on any activity for profit.

- 4. The financial year of the trust shall end on 31st March, every year provided that the Board of Trustees shall be at liber-ty to change the same from time to time if they so deem if fit and proper. The first financial year of the trust shall close on 31st March, 1978.
- 5. The Trustees shall from time to time after a meeting the expenses of and incidental to the management of the Trust properties and of the Trust decide the particular object or objects for which the income or corpus of the Trust fund or properties for the time being available shall be applied.
- 6. The trustees may accept any donation or contribution or subscruption in cash or in kind from any person, firm, company, corporation, associations, institution on trust (including the settler or the trustees or any of them) for the furtherance of the objects of the trust or for any one or more of them upon terms and consitions as they may in their absolute discretion think fit and which are not inconsistant with the objects of the trust. The trustees may also take over the management of any other charitable or public institutions on such terms as they think fit and may manage such institutions.
- 7. Without affecting the generality of powers and functions of the trustees to manage and adminster the trust, the Board of Trustees shall have the following functions.

- i) To arrange for and/or authorise the signing or execution of any agreement, contract, instrument, document or any other paper or writing required to be signed or executed on behalf of the trustees by any two of the trustees to be nominated in this behalf by the Board of Trustees and to make the same effective and binding as if the said agreement, contract, instrument or document or paper or writing were signed by all the trustees.
- ii) To appoint or make provision for the appointment of a sub-committee of trustees and/or others to attend to or supervise or conduct specified jobs or functions or trust matters in such manner and subject to such rules and regulations as the trustees may prescribe.
- iii) To spend any portion of the compus or the income of the trust found for purchasing any land and or constructing any building or buildings for and in the name of the trust for the purpose of carrying out promotion and/or executing any or all of the objects of the trust.
- 9. The trustees shall cause true and accurate accounts to be kept of all moneys received and spent and of all matters in respect thereof in course of management of trust properties or in relation to the carrying out of the objects and purpose of the trust as well as of all the assets, credits and effects of the trust properties.
 - 10. If the income from the trust property in a particular year is not fully utilised, the unexpended income subject to the applicable provisions of the income-tax Act, 1961, shall be carried over to the next year or years and spent in such subsequent year or years for the advancement of any of the object of the trust.
 - ll. The trustees shall keep an account or accounts with any bank or banks, to operate such account or accounts whether in debit or in credit and to give all appropriate instructions to the banker to bankers concerning the operation of such account or accounts and to authorise by appropriate resolution two or more of the trustees jointly with an agrnt appointed by

the Board of Trustees in this behalf to operate such account or

- 12. The trustees may appoint Managing committee, the school which may include the trustees and settlor also. They can appoint teachers and other staff to run the institution and can also dismiss any of the teacher or staff for any misconduct or actions against the interest of the school giving him in course of being heard, Secretaries, Managers, Laywers, Solicitors, Auditors, Architeets, Engineers, Surveyors, Gomastos or other employees for the purpose of management and supervision of the Trust Eetate, for collection of rents, effectos, and profits, for keeping the accounts and records and for other purpose of the trust.
- 13. All the trustees unless they voluntarily resign or otherwise decide, shall continue to be the trustees during the terms of their natural lives.
- 14. The number of trustees shall be not less than two and not more than nine.
- 15. Any trustee may retire at any time without assigning any reason and without being responsible for any costs occasioned by such retirement.
- 10. Two trustees at a meeting shall form a quorum for any meeting of the trustees.
- 17. The trustees for the time being shall elect from amongst them one Chairman and he shall hold office for years, unless he resigns or refuses to act as Chairman or othersise ceases to be ceases to be trustee.
- Meeting of the trustees shall be decided by a majority of votes and in case of equility of votes the Chairman shall have a second or casting vote PROVIDED HOWEVER that notwithstanding anything here in stated no question dealing with the disposal of the corpus of any of the trust properties and/or investment out of the trust corpus shall be decided expect with the consent of the Chairman of the trust.

- 19. In case of difference of opinion between the trustees the opinion of the majority shall prevail and of the trustees are equally divided in any matter, the Chairman shall have a casting vote.
- 20. A resolution in writing circulated amongst all the trustees and signed by a majority of the trustees shall be as valid and effectual as if it had been passed at a meeting of the trustees duly called and covened.
- 21. Notice of the meeting of the trustees and all communications may be sent to the trustees at their addresses registered for the time being in the record of the trust.
- 22. All meetings of the trust shall be held at such place and at such time as the chairman of the trust shall decide from time to time.
- 23. A trustee who is unable to present at a meeting of the trustees may send his views on the agenda in writing and such expression of opinion shall be taken to be his vote on the matter concerned.
- 24. The minutes of the proceedings of every meeting of the trustees shall be entered in a book to be kept for that purposes and signed by the Chairman of such meeting of the following meeting when they are read over and shall when so entered and signed be conclusive evidence of the business and other matters trusacted at such meeting.
- 25. The power to appoint new or additional trustees, but so as not to exceed the maximum number and to fill gacancies in the office of the trustees.
- 26. A person shall cease to be a trustee in any of the following events:-
- a) if he dies, or
- b) if he becomes bankrupt, or
- c) if he becomes insane or otherwise become incapable to act, or
- d) if he resigns his office.



27. On a new or additional trustees being appointed and on his signifying his acceptance in writing to the effect of his accepting the appointment. The trust property shall automatically vest in him along with the other trustees for the time being and he will be entitled to carry out all the duties and functions of a trustees without any other deed or writing.

28. The Board of Trustees shall be entitled to sue in the name of the trust and may similarly be week sued in the name of the trust.

29. The Board of Trustees, may by a unanimous vote of all the trustees for the time being except the trustee proposed to be removed, remove any trustees, permanent or otherwise, from office of the finding the trustee proposed to be removed guilty of serious mis conduct in relation to or concerning the trust estate or trust affairs and after arriving at a definite conclusion that for the reasons to be recorded in writing the continuance of the trustee proposed to be removed as trustee or these presents was desirable keeping to the objects of the trust in view and other related or connected matters provided however that no conclusion of such guilt shall be arrived at without giving to the trustee proposed to be removed a full and fair opportunity of explaining his conduct and/or the charges levelled against him for his removal. And the decision of the Board of Trustees in this behalf shall be final and binding and shall not be called in question anywhere.
